



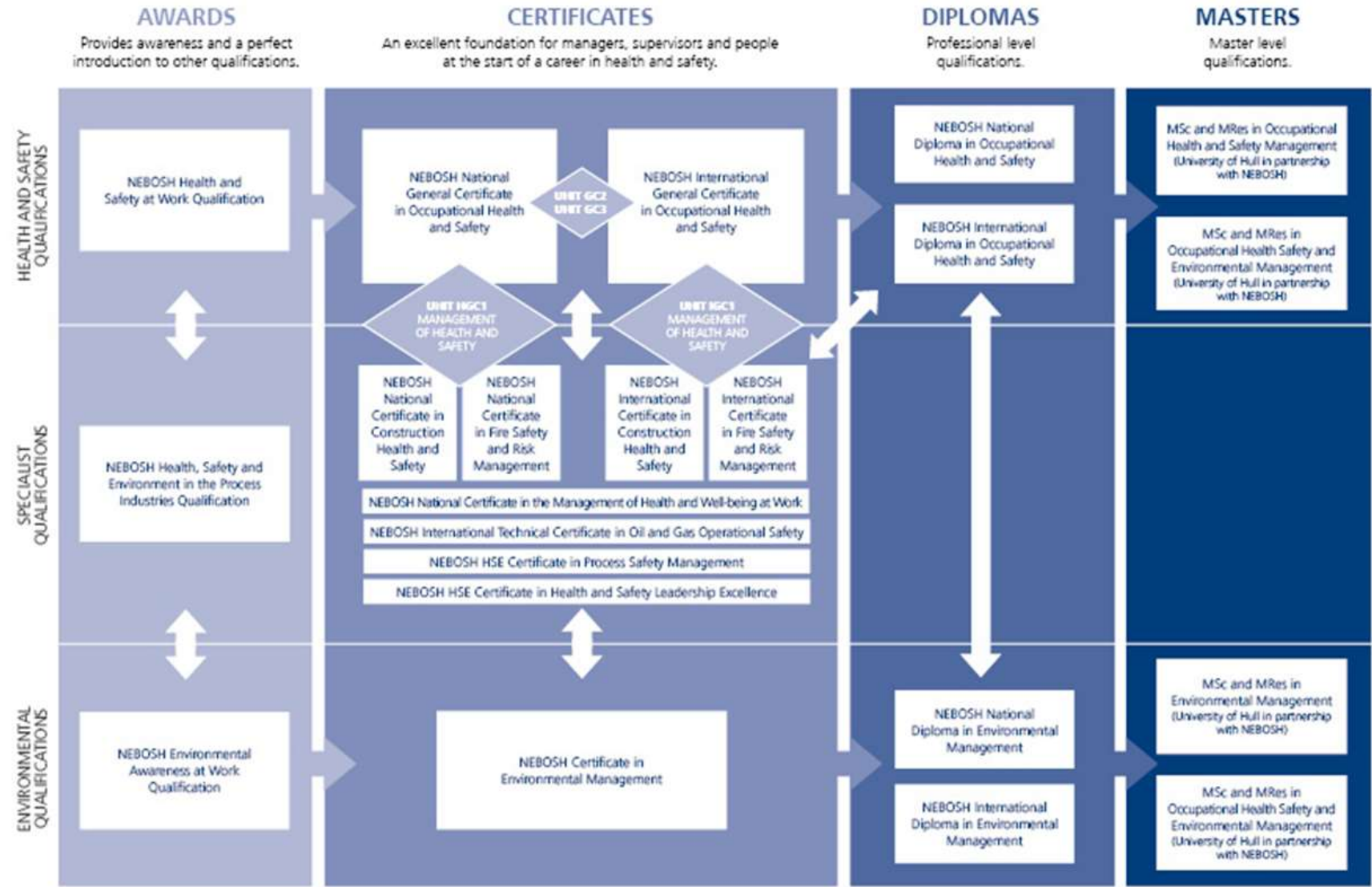

What does the Course Cover?

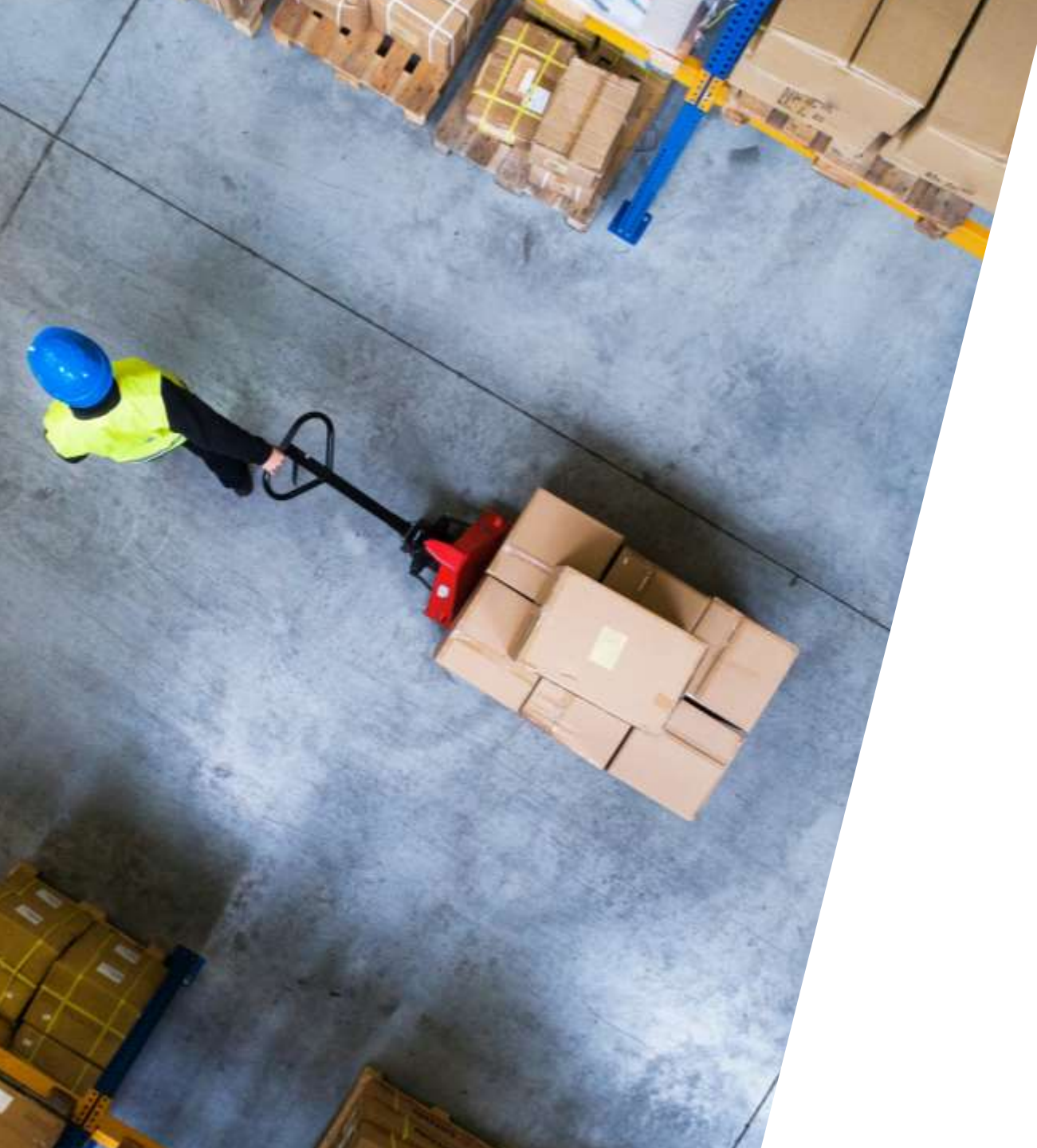
The one day NEBOSH HSE Introduction to Incident Investigation covers:

- How to interview people using the PEACE model

Employer Benefits

- Drives down repeat incidents – learn lessons so the incident doesn't happen again
- Near-misses and minor incidents – such as slips, trips and falls – become “learning events”
- Gives confidence that the approach to investigations is robust and reflects best practice
- Safety culture improves because a proactive approach to incident investigation has been adopted and can be seen
- In-company expertise is built
- Learners' take more care because they have more awareness of how incidents happen and try to avoid them
- Useful from a “business risk perspective” - ensuring incidents are investigated effectively may be useful from an insurance and litigation perspective



How is the qualification assessed?

- The practical assessment takes place during the course or is embedded on eLearning
- The end-of-course assessment asks learners to analyse a filmed case study, critique interview technique, examine evidence, and make recommendations to avoid a recurrence
