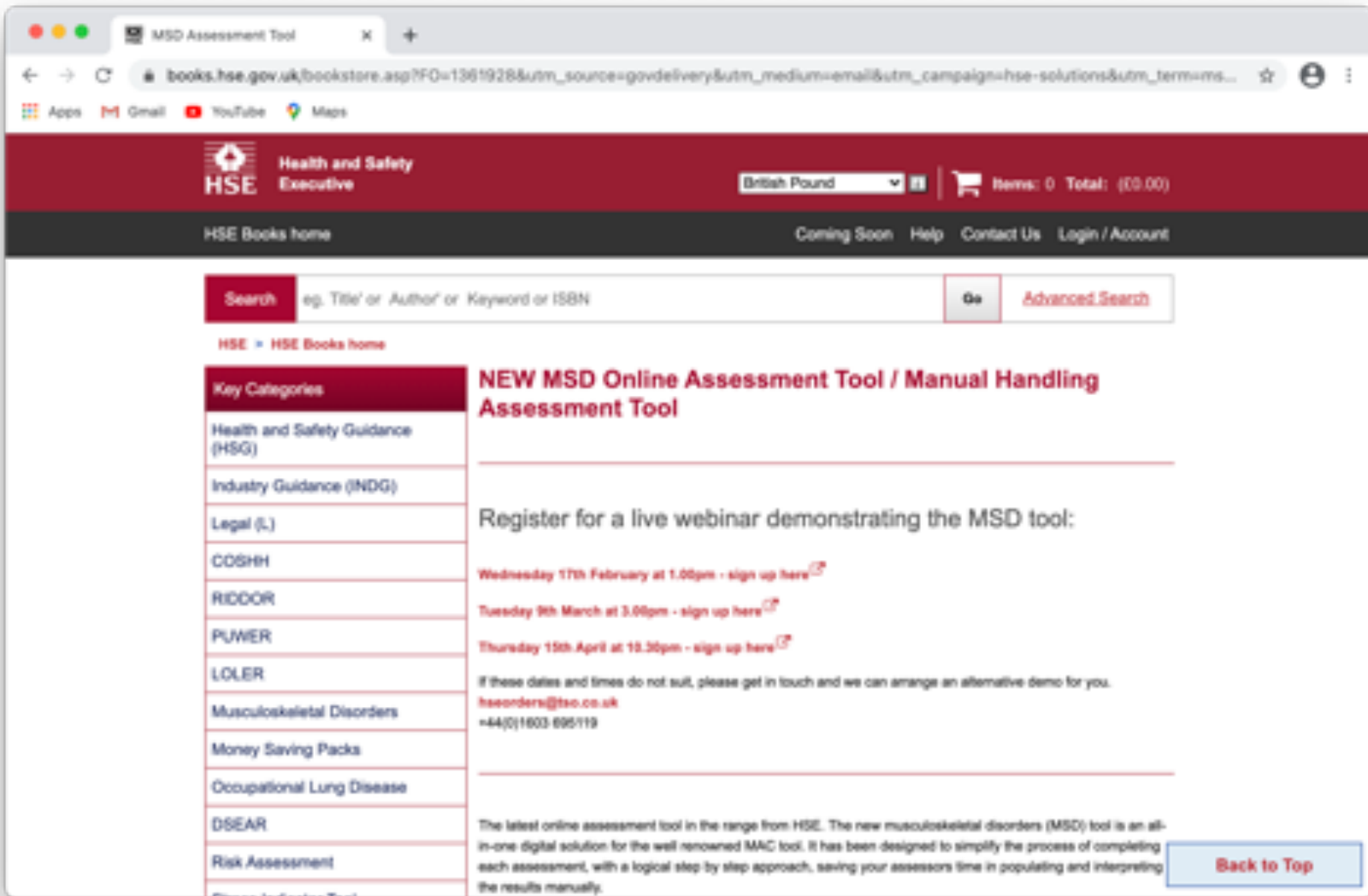

Chromium trioxide authorisation

- Authorisation approved & listed in EU Official Journal before end 2020
- Grandfathered into UK REACH
- But not for decorative chromium
- Supply must come via authorisation holder

Actions

- Notify HSE – 60 days end of transition
- This information should be submitted by e-mail to ukreach.authorisation@hse.gov.uk using the subject 'GB-based DU of an existing EU authorisation (Art 127h)'

Actions

1. Confirm you are an existing authorised DU - include your company identity and contact details.
2. Notify HSE of:
 - a. the existing EU authorisation number;
 - b. any conditions set out in the existing EU authorisation;
 - c. the identity of the supplier of the substance.

Authorisation Numbers

Functional chrome plating where any of the following key functionalities is necessary for the intended use: wear resistance, hardness, layer thickness, corrosion resistance, coefficient of friction, or effect on surface morphology

What should happen

- 1 - Your supplier sends you extended safety data sheet with new exposure scenarios
- 2 - You have to comply with these
- 3 - Chromium trioxide container should be labelled with authorisation number & in MSDS
- 4 - Review period expires 21st September 2024
- 5 - Application for re-authorisation to UK REACH 18 months before expiry date??

Still lots of confusion re decorative chromium plating

OK for other uses until 21st September 2024 but what then?

CTAC-Sub2 undecided re UK REACH re-authorisation

EU REACH re-authorisation €15,000 sign up by end March 2021
